

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What and when is Builders for Babies?

Builders for Babies is a one-day collection event, benefiting our Essentials program, which will be held on Friday, June 21, 2019 at Broncos Stadium at Mile High. Participating companies and individuals are encouraged to drop-off their donations between 10am - 12pm. All donations collected at the event will be distributed to our nonprofit partners that focus on alleviating poverty and ending homelessness.

What is HomeAid Colorado's mission?

HomeAid's mission is to build new lives for Colorado's homeless through housing development and community outreach. We recognize how challenging it can be for families to provide for their most basic necessities and strive to lend a hand to those who need it most by providing them with essential items.

What is diaper need?

Diaper need is the lack of a sufficient amount of diapers to keep a baby clean, dry and healthy. Statistics show that 1 in 3 parents struggle to provide their children with the needed amount of clean diapers which means that children are sitting in unclean diapers for extended periods of time, placing them at a higher risk for infection and diaper rash.

When does HomeAid Colorado's diaper drive begin and end?

The official drive begins on Mother's Day (May 12, 2019) and will run through Father's Day (June 16, 2019).

What items are needed for the drive?

Any brand of disposable diapers, baby wipes and formula. The diapers we need most are 4, 5, 6 and pull-ups. That said, families need diapers of every size, so any donation will make a big difference to a baby in need!

Are there any items that are not accepted?

Unfortunately, we are not able to accept cloth diapers, baby food, toys or any used items.

How many diapers are on a pallet and what is the cost?

On average, there are 6,000 diapers per pallet. The cost varies greatly just depending on the size of diapers you want to purchase, but you can expect a pallet to cost between \$1,100 - \$2,500. Contact Alyssa for more information on the ordering and delivery process.

Can we deliver donations to HomeAid prior to the event?

Unfortunately, HomeAid has limited storage space and therefore cannot accommodate donations before the event, however, there are several public drop-off locations in which you can deliver donations. Check out our website for a list of locations.
